I will write today about your heart and your mind, and how these affect your spiritual development. The Sky Picture

The Sun is in Leo through the 23rd of August. Leo, The Lion, is a fire sign and its ruling planet IS the Sun and you are all about warmth and self expression. You blaze your own path and are very creative, but really do not like change so much as you are a fixed sign. Jupiter is in your 9th solar house (education, travel and religion) and you want to learn and experience new things this year. The window is wide open to take advantage of exciting opportunities. Jupiter is in your natural house of Sagittarius only once every twelve years so take advantage of it! This T-square is similar to what occurred during the Depression in the 1930's. As bleak as the economy is, along with the housing and mortgage industry, it is not as bad as it was in the 1930's. However, we can probably expect more exposure of stock swindles.

From the 12th to the 23rd Chiron and Neptune in Aquarius are opposing the Sun in Leo which will be a great time for reflection for what our dreams are and what we have and have not done to see them fulfilled. Also, Mercury goes

retrograde in Virgo on the 20th until September 12th. Virgo's ruling planet IS Mercury which enhances the repeating of communication in different forms and patterns. All of these energies combined create an atmosphere of reflections about what we want to do and how to do it. 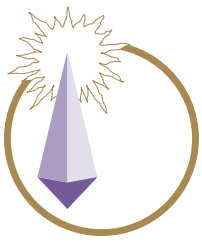
