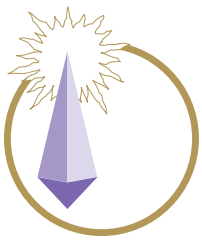

## Doing A 360°

### Sacred Spherical Strategies for Optimal Living

Our focus this month is Tibetan Buddhism, and in particular, two types of meditation used in this sophisticated spiritual system, called *Shamatha* and *Vipashyana*. These different methods work together to reveal the true nature of mind, which is eternally empty, brilliant, calm and clear. Usually, a beginning student learns *Shamatha* initially. It is comprised of two Sanskrit words; *shama*, translated as “calm, peaceful or tranquil,” and *tha* meaning “abiding or letting.” The aspirant “lets the mind be calm” while focusing on an object such as the breath – *consciously* recognizing the effortless inhalations and exhalations.

The second, deeper method of meditation is *Vipashyana*, also Sanskrit, usually translated as “supreme seeing or insight.” According to His Eminence, Khenchen Palden Sherab Rinpoche, *vi* means “extraordinary” and *pashyana* means “seeing.” This extraordinary seeing is what I call “360 Seeing” which means

experiencing the mind from its all-encompassing, pure primordial source... which is unborn, unceasing and free from all duality concepts. This practice transcends ordinary illusory thinking processes. One meditates on the rich emptiness of all phenomena, dissolving the false concept of subject and object, i.e., “you are separate from me.” Success with *Shamatha* helps provide a lovely foundation for “extraordinary seeing” or *Vipashyana*. These two effective techniques are taught in the Vajrayana path which is considered the highest *yana* (vehicle) of the nine *yanas* of Tibetan Buddhism.
